At Little Indies we have exciting places to explore, play, wander and connect and be guided by the 6 Noongar seasons.

Explore, belong, wander, connect, learn, discover, wonder, laugh, create, play, question, imagine, listen and grow!

Inside the gate and outside for an adventure

The Kindy area is where we start our adventures every session. The children can hang up their bags and play in the outdoor area. This is also the place where we have access to toilets and other important facilities. Little Indies is an outdoor programme, however, the well-being of your children will always be our priority. If the children become too wet or cold, or too hot we use the Kindy area as our place of shelter and fun.

The area outside the gate allows for a different type of play and discovery. With items found in the natural world and a few tools with which to explore them, the children use their imagination to explore and discover. This area is close to shelter and facilities should we need them.





Each session will also include an adventure into the bush just behind our school. We take our trolley packed with essentials and off we go! There are nurmerous places for us to stop and play. Depending on the season: we can visit tadpoles, jump in muddy puddles, build cubbies, climb, walk and discover.

The way we explore these places will change depending on the weather. However, each session will include a chance to explore our outdoor environment, an opportunity for a snack and a chance to rest and listen to a story and join in songs and rhymes.

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
